The NARNIA international conference will take place in the University of Cyprus **new** campus Room B108, The University Senate House - A.G. Leventis Building, Panepistimiou Avenue, Aglantzia, Nicosia, Cyprus.

Arrival and Departure

You may use either of the **two** legal points for entry into the Republic of Cyprus. These are the Larnaca airport, which lies about 60 kilometres to the south-east of Nicosia, and the Paphos airport, which is located 140 kilometres south-west of Nicosia.

A shuttle service connects the two airports with Nicosia (<http://www.kapnosairportshuttle.com/>). The shuttle terminus is located in the centre of Nicosia, from where you can take a taxi to your hotel. A single trip with the shuttle bus costs around 8 Euros. Within the city, taxi transportation costs approximately 15 Euros. You can also take a taxi from the airport, but this will cost approximately 50 Euros from the Larnaca airport and 120 Euros from Paphos. There is a taxi stand as you exit the arrivals hall.

Information about travelling to Cyprus

The Cyprus Tourism Organisation has an office in the luggage claim areas of the airports. There you will find maps and other information leaflets, which are given free of charge.

Currency

As of January 2008 the currency in Cyprus is the Euro. Banks have very limited opening hours: 8.30-13.30 Monday to Friday. There are ATMs, however, everywhere and most places accept all major credit cards.

Transportation

For your transportation from the centre of Nicosia to the New University Campus you can take bus no. 150 from the bus terminus at Solomos Square. Please visit the following link for more information about the route details of no. 150.

You should be aware that bus services stop early daily (at approximately 19:00) and there is limited bus service on weekends (some areas have no service on Sundays). Bus fare is paid directly to the bus driver; exact change is required.

Finally, please bear in mind that if you would like to use a taxi for your transportation, you need to call one by phone. You will not find easily a taxi outside in the street, and in the rare case of finding one, it will not stop. Urban taxis are obligatory provided with taximeters and charging commences upon the entering of a passenger in the taxi. There is a taxi piazza in the centre of Nicosia, at Eleftheria square.

Accommodation

There is a private residence house just opposite the University Campus, which offers single and double en suite rooms.
