Guidelines for paper submission

The conference proceedings will be published in the form of an edited volume in the *Journal of Archaeological Science Reports*, which is the new offspring of the *Journal of Archaeological Science* (Imprint: ELSEVIER, ISSN: 2352-409X, editors: A. Howard, C.O. Hunt).

Acceptance for presentation of a paper, and subsequent paper submission for publication do not guarantee acceptance for publication. The papers will be reviewed by the members of the conference scientific committee and reviewers assigned by the editorial team of the *Journal of Archaeological Science Reports*.

Submission

There is a strict **deadline** for the submission of papers set on **Friday, the 31st of October 2014**. The authors must submit their papers directly into the Elsevier online system for the *Journal of Archaeological Science Reports*, by the designated deadline. Papers submitted after deadline expiration will not be accepted for review. Early submissions are most welcome! 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Research Article: A report of original research which assesses the contribution of the research outcomes to the body of knowledge in a given area.

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If you are interested in submitting a paper for review, please read carefully the following requirements regarding the length, formatting, layout, and referencing system of the papers for achieving standardisation. Please note that the following guidelines correspond to the guidelines laid out by Elsevier: <http://www.journals.elsevier.com/journal-of-archaeological-science-reports/>

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5000 words maximum, including references, tables and captions, for the conference oral presentations, and 1500 words maximum, including references, tables and captions, for the conference poster presentations.

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- Use tabs, not spaces, to indent paragraphs; do not use spaces to indent or align any text.
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- Give each table and figure a sequential number and distinctive title.
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Acknowledgements

Collate acknowledgements in a separate section at the end of the article before the references and do not, therefore, include them on the title page, as a footnote to the title or otherwise. List here those individuals who provided help during the research (e.g., providing language help, writing assistance or proof reading the article, etc.).

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Follow internationally accepted rules and conventions: use the international system of units (SI). If other units are mentioned, please give their equivalent in SI.
